DENVER, CO – SALT Electric, a Denver-based full service electrical contractor specializing in sustainable energy, participated in today's green jobs rally and press conference.

Hundreds of solar energy employees marched through downtown Denver to the State Capitol to send a message to legislators encouraging their support of creating more green jobs.
